



Luke, Mark, and Matthew are the Synoptic Gospels (one view) they combine to tell the story of Jesus. Let's lean into how the three books complement and expound on each other.

John will be up next. He is much more interested in theology than story. For example, there aren't parables in John.

I'd like for us to have read through the synoptic Gospels before Kairos. Here a plan to cover Matthew in 10 days:

Day 1: The King's Arrival

Matthew 1:1-2:23

- Genealogy of Jesus
- Birth of Jesus
- Visit of the Magi
- Flight to Egypt and return to Nazareth

Day 2: The King's Forerunner and Early Ministry

Matthew 3:1-4:25

- Ministry of John the Baptist
- Baptism of Jesus
- Jesus' temptation in the wilderness
- Beginning of Jesus' ministry
- Calling of the first disciples

Day 3: The Sermon on the Mount

Matthew 5:1-7:29

- The Beatitudes
- Teachings on anger, lust, divorce, oaths, retaliation, and love for enemies
- Instructions on giving, prayer, and fasting
- Treasures in heaven
- Judging others
- Ask, seek, knock
- Building your house on the rock

Day 4: Jesus' Miracles Begin

Matthew 8:1-9:34

- Jesus heals a leper, the centurion's servant, and Peter's mother-in-law
- Calming the storm
- Casting out demons
- Healing of the paralytic
- Calling of Matthew
- Healing of Jairus' daughter, the bleeding woman, and two blind men

Day 5: Sending Out the Twelve

Matthew 9:35-11:30

- Jesus sends out the Twelve with instructions
- Warnings of persecution and encouragement
- John the Baptist's question from prison
- Jesus' invitation: "Come to me, all who are weary"

Day 6: Parables of the Kingdom

Matthew 12:1-13:58

- Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath
- Healing the man with a withered hand
- Parables of the sower, weeds, mustard seed, hidden treasure, and net
- Rejection in His hometown

Day 7: Miracles and Confession

Matthew 14:1-16:28

- Death of John the Baptist
- Feeding of the 5,000
- Jesus walks on water
- Healing of the Canaanite woman's daughter
- Feeding of the 4,000
- Peter's confession of Christ

Day 8: Teaching and Transfiguration

Matthew 17:1-20:34

- The Transfiguration
- Jesus heals a demon-possessed boy
- Teachings on forgiveness, humility, and marriage
- The rich young ruler
- Healing two blind men

Day 9: The King's Final Week

Matthew 21:1-25:46

- Triumphal Entry
- Cleansing the temple
- Teachings in the temple
- The Olivet Discourse (end times teaching)

Day 10: Betrayal, Crucifixion, and Resurrection

Matthew 26:1-28:20

- The Last Supper
- Jesus' arrest, trial, and crucifixion
- Resurrection and the Great Commission
